## COMBINATION LIFE AND ACCIDENT & HEALTH COVERAGES FILING GUIDELINES

These guidelines should be used when filing policy forms that combine Life and Accident & Health (A&H) coverages or language, when filing a Life rider that will be attached to an A&H Policy and when filing an A&H rider that will be attached to a Life policy.

The Department's authority for Combination Life and Accident & Health coverages may be found at 50 IL Adm. Code 1405.40(q) and 215 ILCS 5/143(1).
