

1 AN ACT to amend the Illinois Insurance Code by changing 43
2 Section 424.

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 47
4 represented in the General Assembly: 48

5 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by 51
6 changing Section 424 as follows: 52

7 (215 ILCS 5/424) (from Ch. 73, par. 1031) 55

8 Sec. 424. Unfair methods of competition and unfair or 57
9 deceptive acts or practices defined. The following are hereby 59
10 defined as unfair methods of competition and unfair and 60
11 deceptive acts or practices in the business of insurance:

12 (1) The commission by any person of any one or more of 62
13 the acts defined or prohibited by Sections 134, 147, 148, 63
14 149, 151, 155.22, 155.22a, 236, 237, 364, and 469 of this 65
15 Code.


16 (2) Entering into any agreement to commit, or by any 67
17 concerted action committing, any act of boycott, coercion or 68
18 intimidation resulting in or tending to result in 69
19 unreasonable restraint of, or monopoly in, the business of 70
20 insurance.

21 (3) Making or permitting, in the case of insurance of 72
22 the types enumerated in Classes 1, 2, and 3 of Section 4, any 73
23 unfair discrimination between individuals or risks of the 75
24 same class or of essentially the same hazard and expense 76
25 element because of the race, color, religion, or national 77
26 origin of such insurance risks or applicants. The application 78
27 of this Article to the types of insurance enumerated in Class 80
28 1 of Section 4 shall in no way limit, reduce, or impair the
29 protections and remedies already provided for by Sections 236
30 and 364 of this Code or any other provision of this Code. 81




